

STANDARD FLOWDOWNS For ORDERS of COMMERCIAL GOODS / SERVICES In SUPPORT of U.S. GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENTS

The clauses in Section 52 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation ("FAR") and Part 252 the Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement ("DFARS") set forth below are each incorporated herein by this reference and made a part of the Purchase Order ("Order").

In all such clauses, the term "Contractor" shall mean "Seller," the term "Contract" shall mean the "Order," and the term "Government Contracting Officer" or equivalent phrases, shall mean "Buyer" as applicable; except that in those clauses conferring patent and data rights to the Government, the term "Government" or "Contracting Officer" retains its literal meaning and is not to be construed as "Buyer." It is intended that the FAR and DFARS clauses as listed herein shall apply to Seller in such manner as is necessary to reflect the position of Seller as a subcontractor to Buyer, to ensure Seller's obligations to Buyer and to the Government, and to enable Buyer to meet its obligations under its Prime Contract or higher-tier subcontract.

The effective version of each FAR/DFARS clause shall be the same version as that which appears in Buyer's Prime Contract, or higher-tier subcontract under which the Order is lower-tier subcontract. In the event of a conflict between these FAR/DFARS clauses and the terms and conditions of the Order, the FAR/DFARS clauses shall control.

This regulation prohibits discrimination against qualified protected veterans, and requires affirmative action by covered prime contractors and subcontractors to employ and advance in employment qualified protected veterans.

	Equal Opportunity for Workers with Disabilities. (1) The clause at 41 CFR 60-741.5 is incorporated herein by reference. The clause applies if this Contract is in excess of \$15,000, unless exempted by the rules, regulations, or orders of the Secretary issued pursuant to section 503 of the act, as amended. As used in the clause, "contractor" means "SELLER." This clause applies in addition to FAR 52.222-36 if included in this Contract. (2) GA-ASI and SELLER shall abide by the requirements of 41 CFR 60-741.5(a). This regulation prohibits discrimination against qualified individuals on the basis of disability, and requires affirmative action by covered prime contractors and subcontractors to employ and advance in employment qualified individuals with disabilities.
